







Scuola Leonardo da Vincio - Florence, Rome, Siena: General Conditions of Participation

- 1. Conclusion of the contract:
- Please send the application form directly to the school centre you have selected. Minimum age of admission is 16 years. The contract is concluded when the school has confirmed your application in writing. The confirmation will be sent to you as soon as possible.
- 2. Payments:
- 2.1. Together with your application, you have to pay the registration fee. Following the receipt of your confirmation, we must receive the paid balance at least 21 days before the beginning of the course. For late enrolments (i.e. less than 21 days) the full amount must be paid upon enrolment.
- 2.2. All payments may be made by credit card (see application form), by International Post Money Order or by International Bank Cheque sent directly to the secretariate of the school centre of your choice. If you transfer sums via bank, you will be charged for transfer costs (ca. 25 Euro). 2.3. To be admitted into the course you will have to produce evidence of payment.
- $2.\dot{A}.\,\, \bar{T}o$ make reservations for accommodation, we need your credit card number as guarantee deposit.
- 2.5. Accommodation must be paid within the first 3 days upon arrival in Italy. Payment should be made in cash or with Traveller's Cheques and in full (not by instalments) for each month or for shorter terms.
- Services:

The contractual services provided appear in the brochure and in the price list. Collateral agreements must be confirmed in writing.

- 4. Cancellations:
- $4.1. \ Cancellations must be sent to the school centre by registered letter, telegramme, fax or email.$
- 4.2. If a cancellation is made more than 21 days before the beginning of the course, the school will refund the total amount except the registration fee, which can be applied to a future course within 12 months after the original course starting date.
- 4.3. If a cancellation is made up to 15 days before the beginning of the course, the school retains the amount of the registration fee, one week's tuition and one week's accommodation. Up to this date, the school accepts the replacement of the registration by another person. In this case, a handling fee of 45 Euro is charged.
- 4.4. For cancellations at a later date, the school retains the amount of the registration fee, two weeks' tuition and two weeks' accommodation.
- 4.5 If cancellation is made after the course has been started, the whole fee for the booked courses are forfeited, i. e. no refunds will be made.
- 4.6 Courses begin only on the published dates. There can be no refund for students who begin their booked courses late, or leave before the end of a session, or miss lessons.
- 5 Lessons:

Lessons are held from Monday to Friday and can take place either in the morning or in the afternoon. Lessons are not held and not refunded on national and local public holidays.

- 6. Accommodation:
- 6.1. On the rare occasions the school is unable to provide the accommodation requested, it will offer alternatives. Accommodation is

- available from the Sunday evening before the beginning of the course to Saturday midday at the end of the course. Different arrival or departure days must be confirmed in writing. The schools only act as intermediary between students and landlords and cannot be responsible for the relations between them.
- 6.2. We need your credit card number as guarantee deposit to make reservations.
- 6.3. A 100 Euro deposit must be paid to get the keys of your accommodation in the apartments. This deposit must be paid in cash at arrival and will be refunded on your departure, less reparation costs if needed.
- 7. Insurance:
- 7.1. Our students are assured (accidents) during their way to school (one hour before lessons start and one hour after lessons), during classes and during organized spare time activities.
- 7.2. Participants are not insured against illness, accidents, theft or loss of personal possessions, either by the schools or by those offering the accommodation. We therefore recommend taking out a personal insurance policy.
- 7.3. During your stay in Italy, you must be personally insured against illness and accident. Citizens from European Union countries are entitled to free medical care in Italy if they hold an E111 form which can be obtained from their local health authority in their home country before departing for Italy. Students from non-EU countries must enquire with the authorities in their countries to know if they are insured during a stay abroad; if they are not covered, they should arrange health insurance to cover their stay in Italy.
- 7.4. Moreover, participants are advised to insure against loss of fees due to non-arrival, absence or unexpected termination of their course.

 8. Visa:
- Western European citizens do not require a visa to enter Italy, if they don't plan to stay longer than 90 days. Citizens of other countries should contact their nearest Italian Embassy or Consulate to check the details regarding entry permits. Our Certificate of enrolment fulfills one of the requirements to obtain a visa. This certificate can only be issued by our school centres after a registration has been received and the registration fee paid. You are responsible for obtaining visas and for any visa-related expenses.
- 9. Personal data:

The participant authorizes the Scuola Leonardo da Vinci to include her/his personal data on a mailing list for the purpose of enrolment. The participant may also periodically receive informative, publicity or promotional material. The participant may at any time, in accordance with Italian law (art. 13, 675/96), request that her/his personal data be removed from the mailing list of the School.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

How to enrol

The first and most important step is to fill out your enrolment form and send it to the Leonardo da Vinci centre of your choice, either by mail, fax or email. You can also use our Internet online application form to enrol. Together with your enrolment form we must also receive proof of payment for the registration fee.

Upon receipt of this, we will send you a confirmation letter with an invoice. If you want to prolong your stay once you are in Italy, you will be pleased to know that it is perfectly possible.

Please do not worry about deadlines as we are committed to flexibility. We look forward to welcoming you to our school at any time. However, the earlier you book, the more likely we can comply with personal wishes or preferences related to your accommodation. And please remember that visa procedures, if necessary, take much time.

Accommodation

Your accommodation is very important. Take your time to make a decision. If you want to discuss your accommodation with us, then please do not hesitate to call the secretariat of our local school centre.

Reservations for Extra Comfort Apartments, Hotels of all categories, Private apartments, Studios and Residences should be made well in advance. For all accommodations: We need your (or your parents') credit card number as guarantee deposit to make reservations.

Usually two weeks before the beginning of your course, and in any event after we have received payment for the courses you have booked, you will receive the address for your accommodation.

Please remember that double rooms can only be reserved for students travelling together.

You are expected to arrive at your accommodation after 12 midday on the Sunday before your course starts. Please inform either the landlord (by phone) or the school (by phone, fax or email), at least four days before you arrive, of your estimated time of arrival. If you don't communicate your arrival time, you will be expected to arrive after 6:00 pm on the arrival day.

You must leave your accommodation on the Saturday after your last course day by 12 midday. If you arrive a day earlier, or if you want to stay a day longer, get in touch with our local school office.

Bed-linens are provided and changed every two weeks (in the Extra Comfort Apartments every week), but you need to bring your own towels. You will be given your own keys, so you can come and go as you please. Students in homestays will be able to receive phone calls; apartments are not provided with telephones. In any case, our schools can provide you with cell phone rental services.

You and your fellow-lodgers are expected to keep your apartment clean, although every two weeks (in the Extra Comfort Apartments every week) an employee will clean the common areas.

Host family accommodation: Half-board includes breakfast and dinner. Remember that you cannot cook on your own. Moreover, be aware that all supermarkets are closed on Sundays.

You may move to a different accommodation during the first three days if you are not satisfied, since the most important thing for us is that you feel at home.

Are you a vegetarian? Are you allergic to house pet? Do you need transfer or do you have other personal wishes or preferences? Let us know as soon as possible and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Please bring a copy of your passport or I.D. card in order to register your living situation with the Italian authorities.

Transfer

Upon your arrival, we recommend you take a taxi to your accommodation. Taxis are easily found at the TAXI stations, which are always in front of train stations and airports. We also provide a personal "Meet and Greet" transfer service from the airports in Rome and Florence and from the train stations in Florence, Rome and Siena to your accommodation. If you would like the school to arrange a transfer, please send us your arrival information (date and time of arrival and flight or train number) with the enrolment form. We can accept a written transfer booking up to one week before your arrival date.

First day at school

We will be expecting you in the main reception area of the school between 8:30 and 9:00 am. After welcoming you to the school, we will do our best so that you feel "at home" right from the start.

If you have little or no knowledge of the Italian language, you will attend your first lesson. All other students take a written and oral placement test which enables us to find the appropriate level. After the test, there is a full orientation session. This describes the school and the programmes and points out important locations. You will also be introduced to the Head of Studies and the staff who are responsible for your well-being. In the afternoon the class lists and timetables will be posted. If you have any questions about the level assigned, you should contact our course coordinator.

Interne

The email address of our schools can be used any time for receiving private emails. Please tell your friends to always mention your name in the «subject»-line of the email. Additionally, Internet cafés are available in walking distance from the schools, where our students receive discounted rates.

Credits, Grants, Bildungsurlaub

German citizens can apply for our "Bildungsurlaub" -recognized courses. Our schools are recognized by most of the German Federal States for the "Bildungsurlaub". Ask for detailed information and please remember to ask in time for making your application (about ten weeks previous to the beginning of the course).


Swedish students can apply for study grants for our schools, as they are recognized by CSN Lund - Sweden.

Academic Credits for US college students can be earned directly for courses taken at Scuola Leonardo da Vinci (Italian 101 and Italian 102). One credit hour is usually earned for each 15-20 classroom hours. Some institutions grant extra credit for cultural programmes or for projects such as "critical thinking" papers. - · By train and bus:
 - Train to Florence, SITA-Bus from Florence Main Railway Station to Siena;
 - Train to Rome-Termini Main Railway Station, train direction Florence, change at Chiusi to Siena train (or with SENA-Bus from Rome 'Tiburtina' Railway Station to Siena).
- by plane:
 - flight to Florence-Peretola (FLR), SITA-Bus to Florence Main Railway Station and to Siena;
 - flight to Pisa-Galileo Galilei (PSA), train direction Florence, change at Empoli to Siena train;
 - flight to Rome-Fiumicino (FCO), with Airport train to Roma-Termini, train direction Florence, change at Chiusi to Siena train (or with SENA-Bus from Rome 'Tiburtina' Railway Station to Siena).
