# ITALIAN TOUR - TRANSPORT INFORMATION

## 1. ITALY BY TRAIN

The cities of **Florence**, **Milan** and **Rome** are connected by fast trains departing every hour during all day. For the fast trains (*Freccia Rossa* or *Italo*) it is necessary to book your seat in advance. The city of **Siena** is connected by Regional trains. For Regional trains it is necessary to buy the ticket at the train station.

### 1.1 FRECCIAROSSA - fast train

Fast trains for connections between Florence, Milan and Rome. The reservation can be done directly at the train station, in a Travel Agency or through the website of the Frecciarossa train: [www.trenitalia.com](http://www.trenitalia.com)

Florence: Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN)  
Milan: Milano Centrale  
Rome: Roma Termini

### 1.2 ITALO TRENO - fast train

Fast trains for connections between Florence, Milan and Rome. The reservation can be done directly at the train station or through the website of the Italo Treno: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

#### **Train stations:**

Florence: Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN)  
Milan: Milano Porta Garibaldi or Milano Rogoredo  
Rome: Roma Ostiense or Roma Tiburtina

### 1.3 TRENO REGIONALE

For trips from/to Florence, Milan, Rome to/from Siena, there are Regional trains. The reservation can be done directly at the train station or through the website: [www.fsitaliane.it](http://www.fsitaliane.it) Please note that these trains are not direct but they make many stops in little towns. In some cases it will also be necessary to change train: please pay attention to the itinerary once you make the ticket.

Rome: Roma Termini  
Siena: Siena main train station

## 2. ITALY BY BUS

Different Bus companies connect the cities of Italy.

### 2.1 SENA BUS

Sena Bus company is suggestable for connections between:

- Milan and Siena
- Rome and Siena

#### Bus stations:

Milan: Milano Rogoredo

Rome: Roma Tiburtina train station

Siena: Siena viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci or main train station in piazza Rosselli

### 2.2 SITA SIENA MOBILITÀ and TIEMME spa

For connections between:

- Florence and Siena

It is not possible to reserve the seats, just buy a ticket at the bus terminal. Tickets are also available at many "Tabacchi" shops. Timetable on <http://www.sienamobilita.it>

#### Bus stations:

Florence: SITA Bus, for connections from Florence to Siena, in Via Santa Caterina da Siena (just behind the SMN main train station)

Siena: TIEMME spa Bus, for connections from Siena to Florence, in Piazza Gramsci or at the main train station in Piazza Rosselli

*For trips from Florence to Milan, Rome or Siena:*

## Florence → Milan

★★★ **by train:** From the Florence main train station (*Firenze Santa Maria Novella - SMN*) you can travel to Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*) with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: <http://www.trenitalia.com/>

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Florence main train station (SMN) to Milano Rogoredo or Milano Porta Garibaldi station. Train schedules and tickets here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

★ **by plane:** From Pisa airport there are planes flying to Bergamo Orio al Serio airport <http://www.ryanair.com/it/voli/roma-ciampino-per-milano-bergamo> .

## Florence → Rome

★★★ **by train:** From the Florence main train station (SMN) you can travel to Rome main train station (*Roma Termini*) with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: <http://www.trenitalia.com/>

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Florence main train station (SMN) to Roma Ostiense or Roma Tiburtina station. Train schedules here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

■ **by plane:** From Florence or Pisa airport there are planes flying to Roma Ciampino airport [www.alitalia.com/IT\\_IT/#](http://www.alitalia.com/IT_IT/#)

## Florence → Siena

★★★ **by bus:** The most comfortable way to go from Florence to Siena is by bus. The bus company SITA is located in Via Santa Caterina da Siena (just behind the main railway station of Florence, SMN). It is not possible to reserve the seats, just buy a ticket at the bus terminal. Tickets to Siena are also available at many "Tabacchi" shops. The last stop in Siena is in viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci, in the center of the city. ★ **by train:** From Florence main train station (SMN) you can travel to Siena main train station with Regional trains. Train schedules: [www.fsitaliane.it](http://www.fsitaliane.it)

From Florence main train station (SMN) we recommend taking a direct train to Siena. Alternatively, there are trains to Empoli at which point you must change and take the connection to Siena.



**For trips from Milan to Florence, Rome or Siena:**

## Milan → Florence

★★★ **by train:** From the Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*) you can travel to Florence main train station (*Firenze Santa Maria Novella - SMN*) with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: <http://www.trenitalia.com/>

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Milano Rogoredo station to Florence main railway station (SMN) every hour. Train schedules here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

## Milan → Rome

★★★ **by train:** From the Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*) you can travel to Rome with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: [www.trenitalia.com/](http://www.trenitalia.com/)

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Milano Rogoredo station to Roma Ostiense or Roma Tiburtina station. Train schedules here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

## Milan → Siena

★★★ **by train & bus:** From Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*) you can travel to Florence main train station (SMN) with the Frecciarossa train. Once arrived in Florence you can take the SITA bus from Florence bus station in Via Santa Caterina da Siena to Siena bus station viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci

★★ **by bus:** From Milano Rogoredo railway station there is a bus (SENA) going to Siena. Tickets and schedule on: [www.sena.it/](http://www.sena.it/)

★ **by train:** There are no direct trains. It is possible to take a fast train from Milano Centrale to Florence SMN. Once in Florence it is necessary to change and take the regional train to go to Siena. **For trips from Rome to Florence, Milan or Siena:**

## Rome → Florence

★★★ **by train:** From the Rome main train station (*Roma Termini*) you can travel by train to Florence main train station (SMN) with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: [www.trenitalia.com/](http://www.trenitalia.com/)

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Roma Ostiense or Roma Tiburtina station to Florence main train station (SMN). Train schedules here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

## Rome → Milan

★★★ **by train:** From the Rome main train station (*Roma Termini*) you can travel by train to Milano Centrale with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance). Tickets and train schedules here: [www.trenitalia.com/](http://www.trenitalia.com/)

★★ Another option is booking ItaloTreno, leaving from Roma Ostiense or Roma Tiburtina station to Milano Rogoredo or Milano Porta Garibaldi station every hour. Train schedules here: [www.italotreno.it](http://www.italotreno.it)

## Rome → Siena

★★★ **by train:** From the Rome main train station (*Roma Termini*) you can travel by train to Siena, changing at Chiusi-Chianciano. Please note that trains between Chiusi and Siena make many stops in little towns (Montepulciano, Sinalunga, and Asciano included).

★★ **by bus:** From the "Roma Tiburtina" railway station you can take a direct bus (SENA) to Siena.

**For trips from Siena to Florence, Milan or Rome:**

## Siena → Florence

★★★ **by bus:** The most comfortable way to get to Florence from Siena is by bus. The bus departs from viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci just a couple of minutes walking distance from the school. It is not possible to reserve the seats, just buy a ticket at the bus terminal. Tickets to Florence are also available at many “*Tabacchi*” shops. The last stop in Florence is right next to the main train station Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN), in Via Santa Caterina da Siena. Schedules on: [www.sienamobilita.it](http://www.sienamobilita.it)

★ **by train:** From Siena train station (a little outside of the city center) it is possible to take direct trains to Florence. Alternatively, there are regional trains with change at Empoli.

## Siena → Milan

★★★ **by bus & train:** From Siena bus stop in viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci you can take the SITA bus to Florence bus station (Via Santa Caterina da Siena) just behind the main train station Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN).

From the train station of Florence (SMN) you can take a fast train to Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*).

★★ **by bus:** From Siena train station (a little outside of the city centre) or from the bus stop SENA in viale Tozzi / Piazza Gramsci it is possible to take a direct bus to Milan Rogoredo station.

★ **by train:** There are no direct trains. It is possible to take a direct regional train from Siena to Florence (SMN). Once in Florence is possible to take the fast train to Milan main train station (*Milano Centrale*) with the Frecciarossa train (it's necessary to book your seat in advance).

## Siena → Rome

★★★ **by bus & train:** From Siena bus stop in viale Tozzi / piazza Gramsci you can take the SITA bus to Florence bus station (Via Santa Caterina da Siena) just behind the main train station Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN).

From the train station of Florence (SMN) you can take a fast train to Rome main train station (*Roma Termini*) with the Frecciarossa. Tickets and train schedules here: <http://www.trenitalia.com/>

★★ **by bus:** From Siena train station (a little outside of the city centre) or from the bus stop SENA in viale Tozzi / Piazza Gramsci it is possible to take a direct bus to Roma Tiburtina station.
