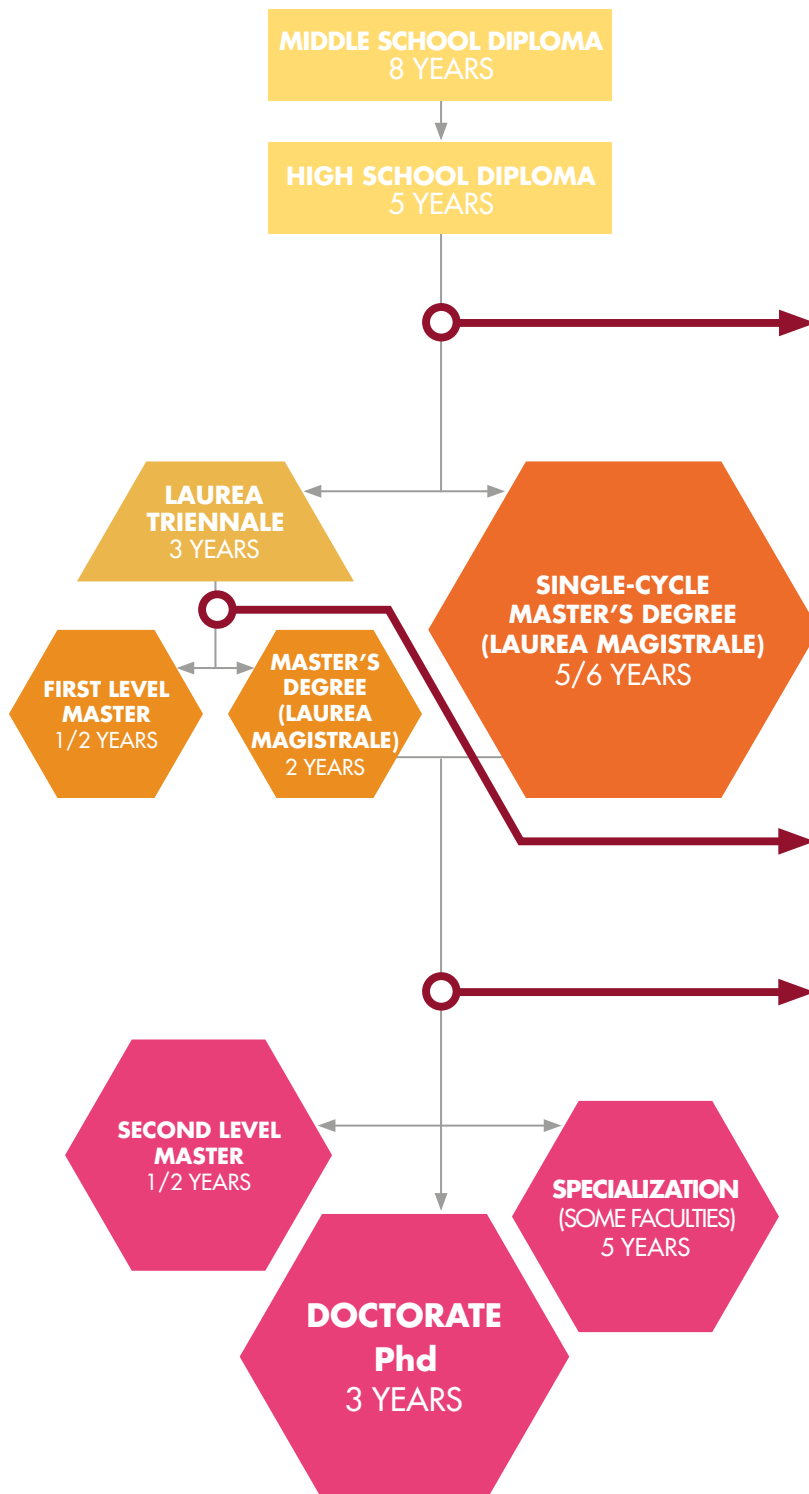

What is IMAT ?

The IMAT (International Medical Admissions Test) is a 100 minutes subject-specific admissions test, designed by Cambridge Assessment, for individuals applying to Medical Surgical, and Dental schools or courses. These courses are taught in English, with spots available for both local and international students.

The universities that require IMAT for admission are: University of Rome "La Sapienza", University of Rome "Tor Vergata", University of Bari, University of Bologna, University of Milan-Bicocca, and University of Naples Federico II.

Our Course Goals

Scuola Leonardo da Vinci in Rome has specifically designed a course to assist students that are preparing for the IMAT exam to acquire scientific competence and improve their logical reasoning skills. The course prepares students for each of the exam's two sections: a) logical reasoning and problem solving; b) specialized knowledge in the field of Medicine. The class will cover testing strategies for specific question types by systematically reviewing recurrent examples from prior test years.

Our Tutoring

Logical Reasoning - General Culture

The logical reasoning part, assists students in developing the following: the ability to choose valid information in order to discover methods and procedures to arrive at a solution; summarize and draw conclusions; identify consequences starting from a series of hypotheses; recognize similarities and differences. Logical, linguistic and numerical questions are all proposed. The general culture section focuses on the main topics concerning modern and contemporary history, literary culture and international institutions.

The goals for this course are set and met by using tests from previous years.

Scientific Contents

This section is designed to provide expertise in several key areas included in the IMAT exam with a particular attention to relevant specialized and technical vocabulary. Precise knowledge of this specialized vocabulary is an essential and highly effective tool to IMAT exam preparation

Chemistry

Atomic structure; the periodic table; chemical bonds; the fundamentals of organic and inorganic chemistry; solutions; oxidation and reduction; acids and bases.

Biology

Cells; bioenergetics; reproduction and inheritance; inheritance and environment: anatomy and physiology of animals and humans.

Physics

Measures; kinematics; dynamics; fluid mechanics; thermodynamics; electrostatic and electrodynamics.

Mathematics

Algebra and numerical sets; functions; geometry; probability and statistics.
