### **FLORENCE**

Florence, in the heart of Tuscany, is the cradle of the Renaissance and the classical Italian of Dante, Petrarch and Boccaccio. While other European cities continued to live in the Middle Ages, modern art and culture developed here under the reign of the Medici. Today in Florence one can visit and admire the masterpieces of artists like Botticelli, Michelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci in world-famous museums (the Uffizi, the Accademia, Palazzo Pitti), in beautiful churches, or even on a casual walk through the city. The Ponte Vecchio connects the lively and historic city center around the Cathedral with the quieter neighborhood on the other side of the Arno river. Florence's urban landscape is distinguished by beautiful squares like

Piazza della Repubblica and Piazza della Signoria, by small streets and winding medieval alleys, by various markets, and above all by the marvelous cupola of the Cathedral, visible from almost everywhere in the city. Today Florence attracts tourists from all over the world who find here, besides history, everything to feel at home: Tuscan food and the best Italian wines, numerous bars and discos, a traffic-free center and many inviting shops.

The Scuola Leonardo da Vinci is situated in a beautiful historical palazzo with a magnificent view of the Cathedral in the heart of downtown Florence, only a few minutes walk from the most famous sights.



### **MILAN**

Milan is the most cosmopolitan and vibrant metropolis of Italy. It is composed of a fascinating mixture of tradition and modernity, design and fashion, culture and Southern European temperament. Its character is stamped by its historical past and its current booming industry. Milan is the city that sets the trends and that's what makes the metropolis so exciting. The area around the Cathedral of Milan, the largest gothic building in Italy, is considered to be the main attraction and an accumulation of superlatives. Here is the location of the "Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II", a catwalk of elegance and the longest arched walkway in Europe. Its Northern exit leads to the "Scala" - one of the most famous opera houses in the world. Not far from the "Scala" you will find the "Castello Sforzesco" - an impressive brick fort which holds the last opus of Michelangelo: the incomplete Pietà Rondanini. And not to be forgotten is Leonardo da Vinci's "Last Supper" in the convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie.

The Scuola Leonardo da Vinci is located in a modern building in the historic center of Milan, just a few minutes' walk from Milan's Cathedral.



### **ROME**

All roads lead to Rome - the eternal city is one of the most beautiful cultural centers in the world and looks back on almost 3000 years of history. The Roman Empire and the Papacy shaped Europe's past, and hurried tourists who only visit the Vatican, the Colosseum and the Trevi Fountain miss out on all the myriad other sights that make Rome a single museum - the Sistine Chapel and the Castel Sant'Angelo, Villa Borghese and the Spanish Steps. But Rome is a living museum! The city on the Tiber with its three million inhabitants has elegant shopping districts and quiet quarters like Trastevere, huge squares like Piazza Navona and picturesque corners around Campo dei Fiori. And thanks to Italy's vibrant joie de vivre, Rome is a fascinating city that also promises relaxation and enjoyment with its street cafés and parks, traditional trattorias and elegant shops.

The Scuola Leonardo da Vinci is located in an attractive and elegant typical aristocratic building in the center of Rome, in the pedestrian area, halfway from the astounding Piazza Navona, Castel S. Angelo and St. Peter Basilica.



### **TURIN**

Turin, with its 18 km of arcades, is one of the most fascinating and mysterious cities in Italy. Its magic exists in the fusion of art, history and avant-garde. Under the patina of a Savoyard rigor pulsate a liveliness and vitality that not only amaze, but literally captivate the visitor: Baroque palaces and futuristic architecture, ancient art collections and international film reviews, our Egyptian Museum is the second most important of its kind in the world due to its unique exhibits. And then the refined Savoy residences, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which with their sumptuous gardens recall the refined life of the Turin court.

The tradition of the first Italian capital lives on in the historic cafes and restaurants of the center. A complex industrial fabric and top-

level universities make Turin one of the main technological and scientific centers in Italy. The 2006 Winter Olympics brought the mountains surrounding the city of Turin to the fore and made it an ideal destination for winter sports lovers.

Our school is located in an elegant Art Nouveau building in the exclusive residential district of Crocetta, just a few minutes' walk from the old town and the pedestrian area.



### **VIAREGGIO**

Viareggio is on the Tuscan Riviera, just 30 km from Pisa. Due to its convenient location, it is the ideal starting point for numerous excursions. Those who want to enjoy culture can easily reach the nearby cities of Lucca and Pisa by train or car, but Florence can also be reached in just over an hour. Nature lovers don't miss out either. The nearby Cinque Terre and the island of Elba offer wonderful destinations for trekking and hiking in untouched landscapes. The marble quarries of Carrara, from which the famous white marble used by Michelangelo in his sculptures comes, are easily accessible and certainly worth a visit.

The seemingly endless beach, the palm-lined beach promenade, the elegant boutiques, the restaurants with excellent cuisine and the exciting nightlife with the well-known discotheques of "Versilia" - all this makes Viareggio a popular holiday destination. A holiday here offers, among other things, meeting many young people and enjoying the excellent sea specialties of Tuscany. Viareggio is the ideal holiday destination for those who love sea, sun and fun.

Our school is in a two story building with nine classrooms and faces a small and traffic-free pine forest. The central location of the school makes it possible to reach the lively market square, the beach and the beach promenade in just a few minutes.

### **INTENSIVE COURSES**

The Intensive Course is held throughout the year at all six ability levels (A1 - C2 = ability level scale according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR).

The tuition of 4 lessons daily takes place from Monday to Friday and usually starts at 9 am in the morning. If there are a large number of participants, the intensive course can also be held in the afternoon. The size of each course group is limited to a maximum of 14 students. Start of courses every week; Beginners usually every 14 days. Course duration 1 to 48 weeks. 4 lessons per day, 20 per week.

### **SUPER INTENSIVE GROUP COURSES**

In the Super Intensive Group Course, you will attend 4 lessons of Intensive Course and 2 additional lessons of group classes per day, in which the practical use of the language and conversation will be encouraged. The additional lessons are conducted at 3 skill levels: Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced.

### SUPER INTENSIVE «PLUS» COURSES

Our Super Intensive «Plus» courses offer a combination of group course and individual lessons. In private lessons, your personal difficulties with the Italian language will be specifically addressed. The following courses are available: Super-Intensive Plus-5 Course: 20 lessons of Intensive Course plus 5 lessons of private tuition per week; Super Intensive Plus-10 Course: 20 lessons of Intensive Course plus 10 lessons of private tuition per week.

### **«ITALIAN TOUR»**

### SENIOR COURSE 50+ «LA DOLCE VITA»

This course is specifically designed for mature students of all ages. Students will learn Italian in a pleasant and relaxing environment, accompanied by a wide variety of cultural activities. Participants can choose among the most beautiful Italian cities: Florence, Milan, Rome, Turin or Viareggio.

Morning Program: The morning course of Intensive Italian Language is designed to improve language and conversational skills, and heighten the awareness and appreciation of the Italian culture.

The Afternoon Program depends on the locality and course center. Some program examples: Orientation tour of the city; Guided tours of Museums; Traditional Italian dinner with program instructor; Tour of Artisan Workshops (Ceramics, Etching, Florentine paper, Shoemaker, etc.); Half-day excursion to a vineyard and other breathtaking areas of the Region; Professional lectures in History of Italian Opera; Wine tasting with professional sommeliers. ### PREPARATION FOR LANGUAGE DIPLOMAS

Our schools are recognized examination centers by the Accademia Italiana di Lingua<sup>®</sup> (AIL) and the University for Foreigners of Siena (CILS). You can prepare for the various language diplomas with us. We organize preparatory cycles (intensive courses combined with an exam course) for all levels: A1 - C2.

### **ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR - «GAP YEAR»**

Do you want to live 'all'italiana' and become the real connoisseur of Italian culture and society? Then you will definitely be interested in this course. It's a 32 week language and culture course which combines Italian language with Italian culture, art and history classes. Attending this course, you will have the opportunity to see at first hand the various aspects of Italy's rich history and culture. The course is composed of two elements: linguistics and academics.

The linguistic part consists of 480 lessons of the Intensive Italian language course and 80 lessons of preparation for two Diplomas «Firenze» AIL exams.

The academic part (80 lessons) treats a large number of major subjects like: Italian Civilization and History, Art History, Business Italian, History of Italian Fashion and Design. Furthermore, there will be 10 contact hours of tutoring for the Final Research.

On request, we can organize the year abroad with stays in all of our course locations - Florence, Milan, Rome and Turin. Information is available directly from our school centers.

### **GAP SEMESTER**

The exam day is also the last day of the course.

### Extract of the general conditions of participation to facilitate registration.

### A) Enrolment and payment:

The request for registration must be sent directly to the School of your choice, and can be managed independently only by people of legal age: those under 18 must present the request through their parents or legal guardian, who will confirm on their behalf acceptance of these Conditions, by filling out and signing the relevant forms.

Please register at least 4 weeks before the beginning of each course you have chosen

The minimum age for attending the courses is 16.

Together with the request for registration, the School must receive the payment of the enrolment fee and a deposit amounting to 20% of the full price of each chosen course as an advance on the full fee. Taken together, these make up the confirmation deposit which will not be refunded in case of cancellation. Students needing a visa must follow a different procedure (see below, paragraph Visa). Upon receiving the registration and the payment, the School will confirm by email without delay.

The outstanding amount of the full fee for each chosen course must be paid at least 14 days before the course itself starts. For "last minute" registrations (made at least 14 days before the beginning of each chosen course), the School requires immediate payment of the enrolment fee and the full fee for each chosen course. The School accepts payment by bank transfer (in this case, make sure banking expenses are charged to you, choosing the "OUR" banking expenses payment option) or by credit card (see the form at the bottom of the registration request).

#### B) Lessons:

Lessons are normally held from Monday through Friday, but for reasons of organisation and/or force majeure also on Saturday, and may be held in the morning or in the afternoon. Courses are not held on local and national holidays, and are unrecoverable. Please check the list of holidays on our calendar.

#### C) Cancellation:

The request for cancellation must be sent to the School in writing, by return registered mail or by email, at least 15 days before the beginning of the course. In this case, the enrolment fee and the deposit (confirmation deposit) for each chosen course will not be refundable.

Cancellations which come too late (that is from the 14th day before the beginning of the course onwards) will be equivalent to a no show, and this will not give right to a refund.

If the cancellation has been made after attending or having had access, in whole or in part, to the course, the student will not be entitled to any refund.

The courses will start on the dates indicated by the School. No refund will be made to a student who begins the course late, who leaves before the end of the session or who misses lessons without a valid reason.

#### D) Changes in delivering the service:

The School will make sure each course is provided in the manner described on the portal <a href="https://www.scuolaleonardo.com/">https://www.scuolaleonardo.com/</a> or elsewhere (e.g. in brochures).

The School may withdraw at any time, without any liability towards the student, should it not be able to provide in full the chosen course for reasons not under its reasonable control: in this case the School will not be liable for any costs incurred by or on behalf of the student (by way of example and not limitation: medical costs due to Covid-19 infection, accommodation and repatriation) but will communicate to the latter the cancellation of each course providing the latter with an opportunity to choose, no later than 15 days after receiving such notice, between:

- a) should the course originally chosen be on-site, the activation of a similar online course;
- b) in any case, the delivery of a voucher for receiving a similar service, to be used within 24 months after being issued, and after agreeing with the School on the new educational calendar.

#### E) Lodgings:

The School provides the students - according to the preferences they express - with useful advice on finding suitable accommodation (with families, in shared flats, private flats, studios, residences, B&B, hotels of every class, etc.), facilitating direct contact with the owners or management.

Minors may lodge only with families on a half-pension basis.

The School will also provide all the information necessary for making the booking (such as indicative prices, check-in/check-out rules, etc.), however this will be managed independently by the student or the person acting in the student's place, directly with the host and, we suggest, sufficiently in advance.

#### F) Insurance:

Students enrolled in the courses delivered by the School are insured against any accidents which may occur during the on-site lessons and during the activities organised by the School.

During their stay in Italy, the students must be insured personally for illnesses and accidents (Italian law). Citizens of countries of the European Union, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Iceland are entitled to receive free health care in Italy if they hold the European health insurance card (EHIC-Card), which they can collect at the Social Security centre of their country of origin, before leaving for Italy. Non-EU students must check with the competent authorities of their own country whether they are insured for a stay abroad.

We also strongly recommend students to take out insurance against failure to refund payments made at our School in case of illness, costs due to a pandemic situation, repatriation, delayed annulment, failure to show up (so-called no show), absence at courses or advance departure.

#### G) Visa

Should the student need an entry visa for Italy, we suggest first of all taking a look at the information available on the webpage

https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en, and getting in contact with the nearest Italian Embassy or Consulate in order to check details on how the visa and the following permit of stay will be issued and how long it will take.

The student must be sure to apply for the Visa in time to get it before the beginning of the course, promptly advising the School by email of any delay or rejection, in order to agree on a new beginning date for the course/courses, compared to the one originally booked.

The student is responsible for obtaining the Visa, and for all related expenses. Once the School has received the registration request and evidence that the advance and overall payment has been effected for each chosen course along with the enrolment fee (necessary to confirm the booking), the School will send - by email/conventional postal delivery - the specific registration certificate for the Visa (fulfilling one of the requirements for validly obtaining issue of the Visa) and any other document within its competence which may be needed.
